Gene Swearingen of Centreville, VA, began work as our new Town Manager Tuesday, January 16, 2007. The Town Council, Mayor and staff are excited about the prospect of working with Gene on town issues, improving services to the community, and accomplishing the goals outlined in the comprehensive plan.

Middle School Boundary Plan

During the latter months of 2006, several residents of Greenhill Crossing approached the Town Council with concerns regarding proposals for Middle School boundary adjustments, principally regarding "Plan 1d" which if implemented would have resulted in a large number of Haymarket's middle school students attending the new school located across route 29 at "Wentworth Green" .

As a result of resident's concerns, the Town Council reviewed the boundary committee's proposals and forwarded a resolution to the County School Board detailing the Town's opposition to Plan 1d and support for Plan 2, based on concerns related to safety, traffic and the general welfare of the students,

At the January 17, 2007 meeting of the Prince William County School Board, board members voted unanimously for Plan 2, ensuring that all of Haymarket's middle school students will remain at Bull Run Middle School for the foreseeable future. The Town Council would like to thank all of those residents whose participation, organization and public comments helped ensure the defeat of Plan 1d.
